



The production of 3.34 million tons represents an 8% annual increase. a figure still far from the needs of a developed society.



Energy Recovery

The substitution rate reached 46%. This utilization of the calorific value of waste allowed Catalan factories to avoid the emission of more than 354,000 tons of CO_a from fossil fuels, resulting in a significant contribution to the fight against Climate Change.

Material Recovery

The utilization of by-products or waste as raw materials for production experienced a growth of 44% in 2022. This allowed saving the extraction and consumption of more than 288,000 tons of natural resources, a 60% increase compared to the previous year.

Environmental Investments

The utilization of waste for cement production accounted for nearly half of the environmental investment in 2022, followed by the field of energy efficiency. It is also noteworthy that funds allocated to the control of environmental effects increased by 254% compared to the previous year.
